Very clear Terms of Service and Acceptable Use In provisioning process, checkbox, "Will you be hosting illegal content?"

Monitor your customer's content

Be Inconsistent

Be unresponsive to questions

Be unresponsive to LEO's

Be unresponsive to Abuse@provider.porn
